The Tax Court of Canada ceases its operations at its Hamilton location

As a result of ongoing security concerns for the public, employees and Members of the Court, the Tax Court of Canada has made the decision to cease its operations at its current Hamilton location, permanently and effective immediately.

Registry services will no longer be provided on site. Parties wishing to file documents with the Tax Court of Canada may do so electronically, in person at another office of the Court, by mail or by fax. We are aware that this measure will cause inconvenience and delays for parties in the Greater Toronto Area, Hamilton and Niagara. The Tax Court of Canada has requested that the relocation process be accelerated.

Parties with hearings scheduled in Hamilton will be contacted directly by Registry staff in the coming days.
